Feel free to join them and casually (or not so casually) swim into other singles. But your fun here isn't contingent on the season — Jimmy at The James is a year-round rooftop experience. The 18th-floor buzzy bar with a casual lounge area has 14-foot-high windows through which you can glimpse 360-degree views of Manhattan. After you've made a few friends, retire to the onsite David Burke Kitchen to split table-friendly eats like peanut butter maple bacon dates or cornbread-crust oysters.
