In a Tin Shaker:

- 5oz Olive Brine
- 1 oz Dry Vermouth
- 2 oz Tito's Vodka
- 2 dash Celery Bitters
- Less than the back of a bar spoon of A-1 Steak Sauce
- Shake to temperature
- Strain into a martini glass
- Garnish with olives
